

## **Bromley Pre-School Provider Local Offer**

Bromley Methodist Church Pre-school is an inclusive early years setting and offers the following range of provision to support children with SEND to meet their individual needs.

### **Assessment, Planning and Review:**

How can I find out how well my child is doing?

- Conversation with the key person, SENCO and/or Pre-school Leader
- Access to child's profile through the key person
- Through settling in and end of year reports
- By attending the pre-school coffee mornings once a term
- By access to observations and records

How will my child be supported with their development/medical/physical needs? (eg staff training for medical needs, teaching programmes)

- Individual Education and Medical Plan
- Medical needs training eg EpiPen training, first aid, disability awareness training and childcare development training.
- Small group and one to one activities with key worker/SENCO
- 2 year old specific activities
- Whole group activities

What additional facilities are provided for my child with special educational needs and disabilities? (eg wheelchair access, clinical care)

- Wheelchair access inside and outside
- Additional toilet outside main hall for disabled, with access for wheelchair
- Allergies catered for (eg specific dietary requirements, EpiPen etc)
- Medical needs catered for (eg inhaler)

### **Partnership**

What support from outside agencies does the setting currently use to support my child?

- Speech and language therapist
- Sensory support
- Portage
- SEND adviser
- Health visitor
- SIP's

### **Transition**

How will my child's transition into school be supported?

- Transition document
- End of pre-school report
- Conversation with school teacher/school SENCO
- Visit to the pre-school by reception teacher
- All relevant paper work passed on to the school with transition form
- Transition meeting with the school if required
